


In Support of INK 2023 The Halesworth Bookshop is supporting Author Events with book sales across the weekend, do come and join us


Following their performance we will have a collection of both Alexei's and Luke's books on sale in the foyer, offering the opportunity to meet the authors and purchase signed copies.
